# Tenth Annual Music Showcase

(Practice 12 noon – 1 p.m.)

Location: Berry College – Bell Recital Hall  
(Formerly Ford Auditorium)

1. Music Showcase contestants must be students in good standing with their respective schools and currently registered in Grades 9-12 in Rome/Floyd County or be a Homeschool student residing in Rome/Floyd County. Groups of 5 or fewer members, including an accompanist, if needed, may participate. Education scholarships will be presented to winners: 1<sup>st</sup> place \$1000, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$500, 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$250. Deadline to receive applications is Wednesday, March 18, 2020. (See application.)

2. The Music Showcase act is limited to a vocal or instrumental performance and is limited to a **4-minute** performance time. (Try to perform a minimum of 3 minutes.) Except for an accompanist, only amateur talent may participate. Background soundtracks that are used for vocal performances shall be instrumental only--no vocal backgrounds. Participants must have own instruments except for piano. Winners will be announced on the day of competition. **Certificates of Scholarship** will be presented to winners at the Kiwanis annual Scholarship Banquet on Tuesday, May 5, 2020, 6 p.m., Oakhill Church of Christ, 1500 Martha Berry Blvd NE, Rome, GA.

3. A maximum of 20 acts will be accepted on a first-come, first-to-qualify basis.

4. Music Showcase 1<sup>st</sup> place winner may be able to compete at the district-level (in Leesburg, GA) on April 25, 2020, where 1<sup>st</sup> place District-level winner will receive a \$3500 education scholarship; 2<sup>nd</sup> place, \$2500; 3<sup>rd</sup> place, \$1000, and 4<sup>th</sup> place, \$500.
